

Driver

The driver behaves in a professional manner, and follows instructions of the depot's employees

The driver is able to communicate with employees, in (basic) English, or Greek

The driver holds a valid license for the type of vehicle to be driven and is authorised to drive vehicles carrying the specific classes of product

The driver has basic product knowledge for the products carried

Carrier has to ensure that drivers are complied with all proactive measures for drivers against COVID -19 that are in place for LPC's, MOH's installations and Coral premises (as per attached sheet)

The driver should be equipped with the standard PPEs as per below table

Vehicles

Vehicles are operated within the permissible gross weight specified by the manufacturer and in accordance with local regulations

Meets all local safe to load requirements

The vehicle is fitted with seatbelts and relevant safety equipment

- Fire extinguisher dry powder operative
- First aid Kit
- Warning triangles
- Anti-spill equipment
- Safety rail on top in case of working at height

3" female camlok (see attached photo)

Written confirmation that the truck doesn't operate in liquid food loading

Cleaning certificate providing the last three cargos. In case of ADR cargos, a gas free certification should be provided additionally

Other

In case of delays, the loading may not be performed since there is also a deadline for customs clearance.
